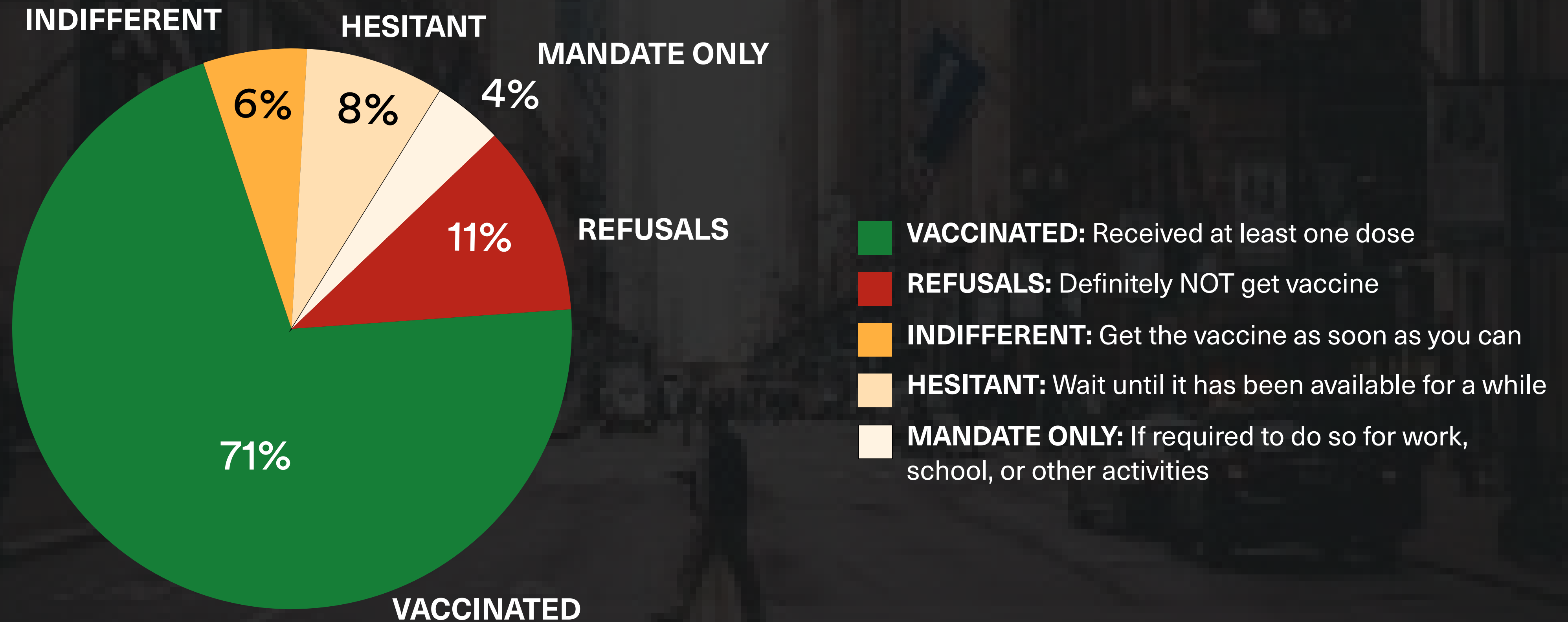
**Only 11%** outright refuse the vaccine

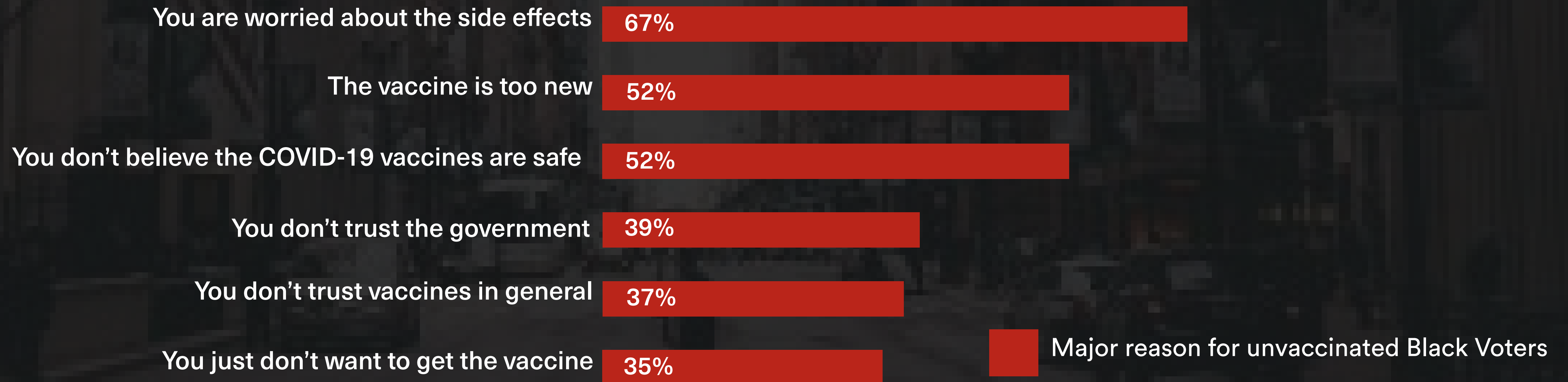

Mandates are also **effective** amongst unvaccinated Black voters

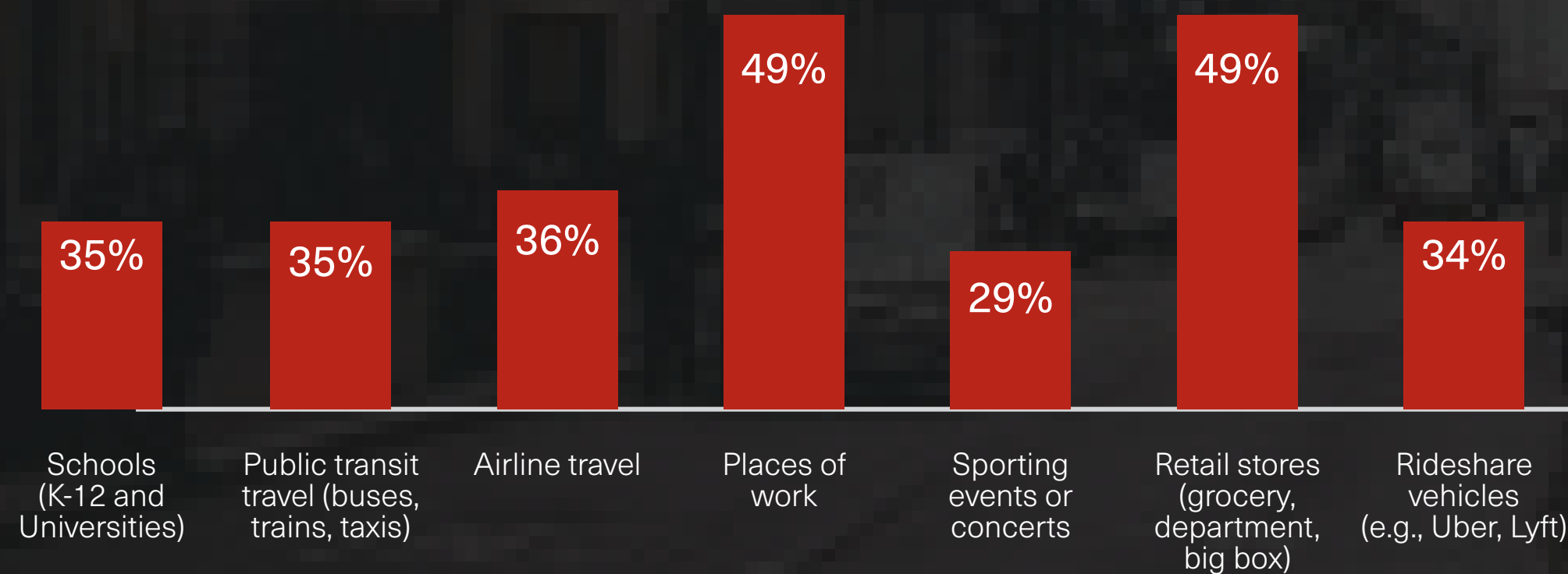

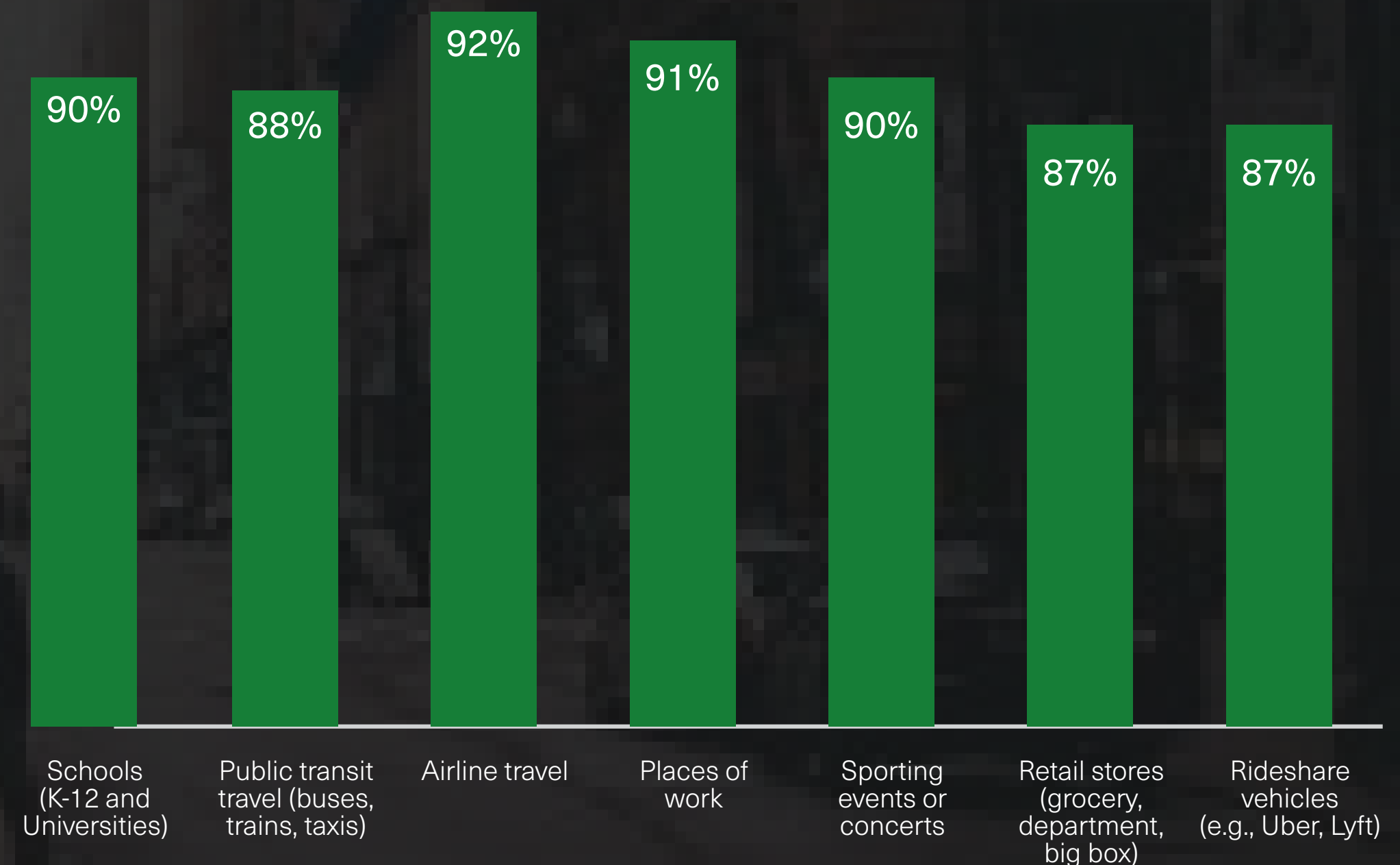

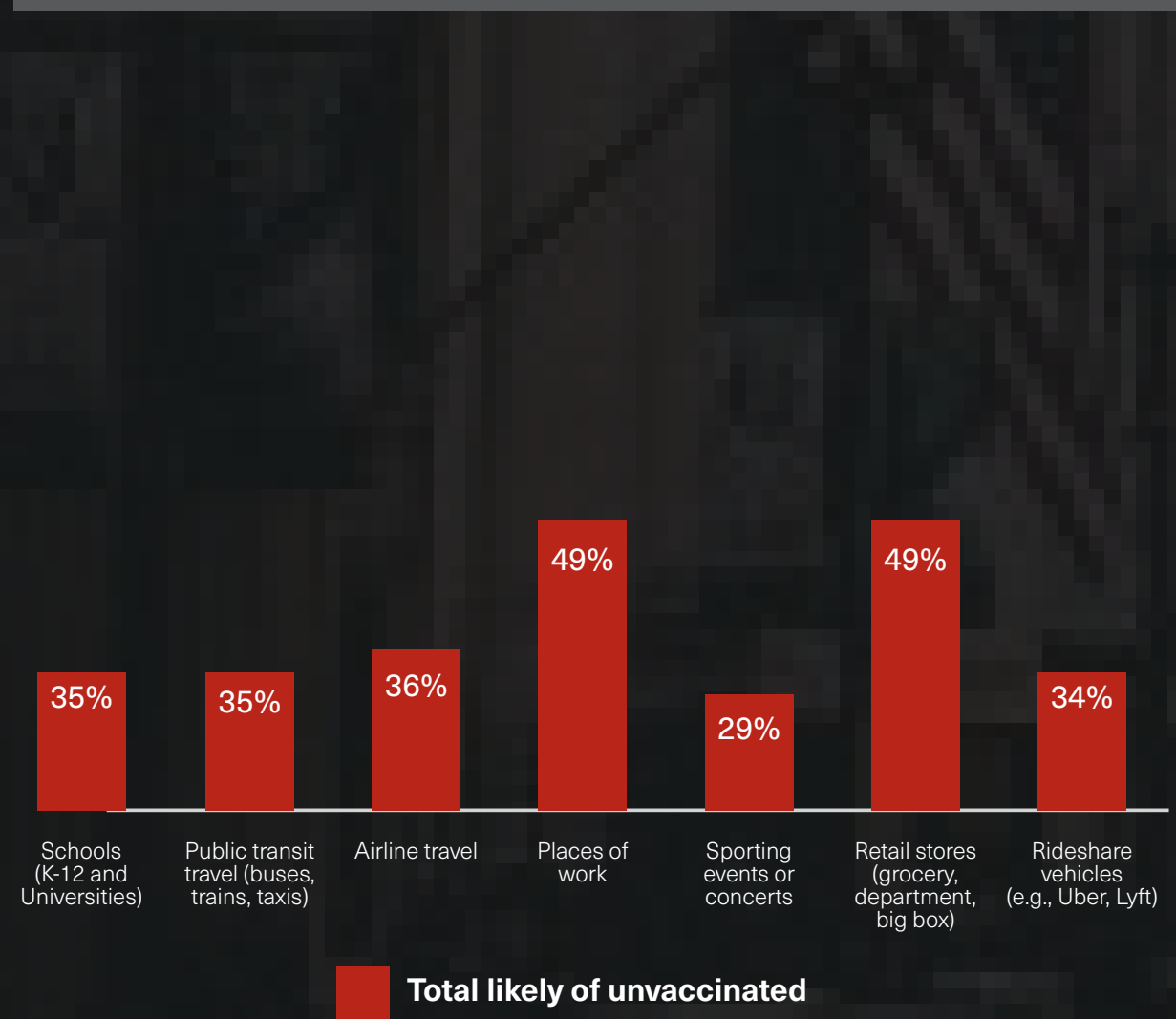

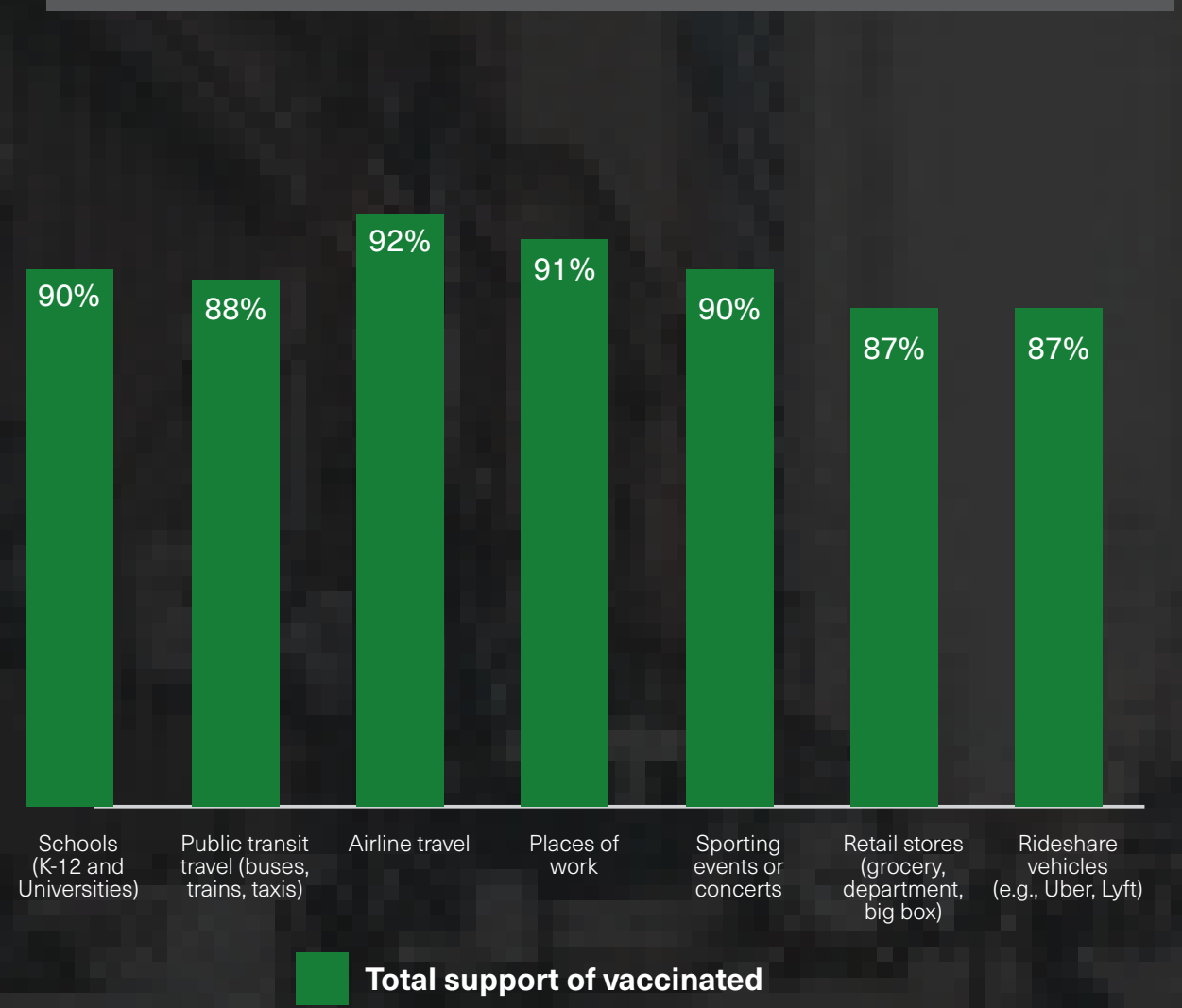


# 49% of unvaccinated Black Voters would get the vaccine if it was mandated at work and retail stores.

How much do you support or oppose a vaccine mandate for the following places?

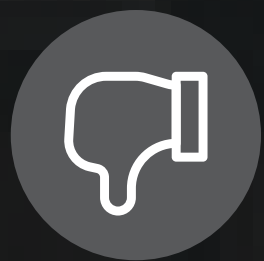
