


# Opinion on the Temporary Child Income Tax Credit


(Families earning up to \$150,000)


**69%** of Democrats think Child Income tax credit should be permanent.


(Low-income families)


**70%** of Democrats think Child Income tax credit should be permanent.



**60%** of Republicans think Child Income tax credit should NOT be permanent.




**58%** of Independents think Child Income tax credit should be permanent.



# America's Voting Bloc




