

Black Voters Respond To U.S. Capitol Attack

BlackTrack is HIT Strategies' recurring monthly survey of 1,000 national Black voters on current social and political issues. This survey was fielded from January 21-23, 2021, conducted via online panel and phone, with a margin of error of +/-4% at a 95% confidence level.




How comfortable or uncomfortable are you doing the following activity with [Trump Supporters OR Republicans]?

> What are the best ways to hold the people responsible for the events at the US Capitol on January 6th in Washington, DC?


Prosecute and jail anyone who entered the Capitol building illegally on the 6th

Vote every elected official that was responsible out of office




Expel Republican members of Congress responsible from their elected office

Expel Republican members who objected to the certification of election results

Most Black voters use violent language to describe the attack on the U.S. Capitol

How would you best characterize the events that took place at the US Capitol on January 6th in Washington, DC?

33% Domestic Terrorism 16% Insurrection 16% Violent Protest

15% Riots 9% Attempted Coup 7% Uprisings 4% Peaceful Protest

Black voters see the BLM protests as peaceful and justified, whereas the events of January 6th were domestic terrorism and unjustified

Black voters saw:



The Police Brutality Protests following George Floyd's killing:

72% Justified



The January 6th events at the US Capitol:

73% Unjustified

Black voters are divided on whether Congress should prioritize progressive agenda or impeachment and investigation hearings.
