Re: Rep. Jasmine Crockett Decisively Leads the Democratic Primary

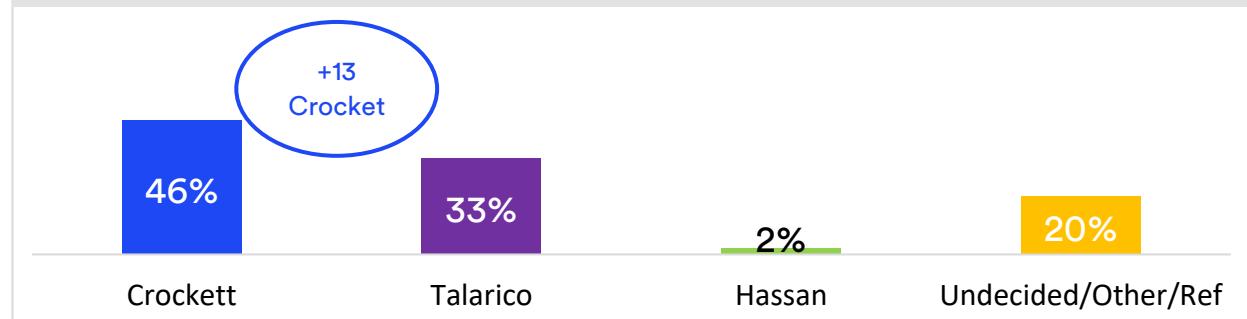
Representative Jasmine Crockett retains a decisive lead among Texas' likely Democratic primary voters, outpacing Representative James Talarico by 13-points. She holds a commanding lead among key Democratic constituencies, generates significant enthusiasm among voters that a Democratic nominee will need in November, and is seen as the most electable choice by likely Democratic primary voters.

- Takeaway #1 – Congresswoman Crockett remains the Democratic primary leader:** Congresswoman Crockett continues to hold a decisive lead in the Democratic primary, leading Talarico by 13-points. Crockett is outperforming Talarico across nearly every voting bloc including with strong support among Black voters (80% Crockett, 10% Talarico), 4/4 Democratic primary voters (49% Crockett, 39% Talarico), and self-identified Democrats (48% Crockett, 35% Talarico). This poll confirms that Jasmine Crockett is likely the best candidate to reassemble the Democratic coalition that has eroded in Texas over several election cycles.

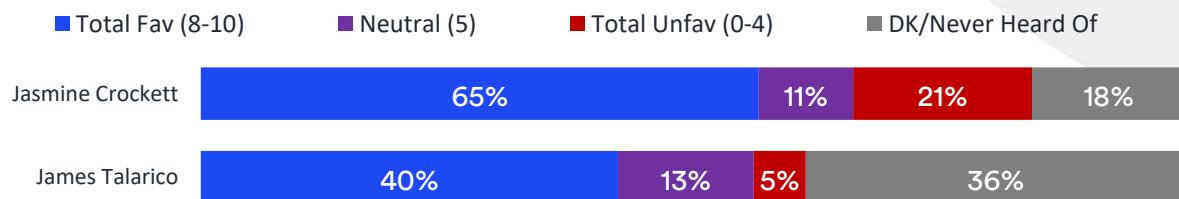
If the Democratic Primary for U.S. Senate were held today, for whom would you vote? [If Undecided]

[Includes Leaners]



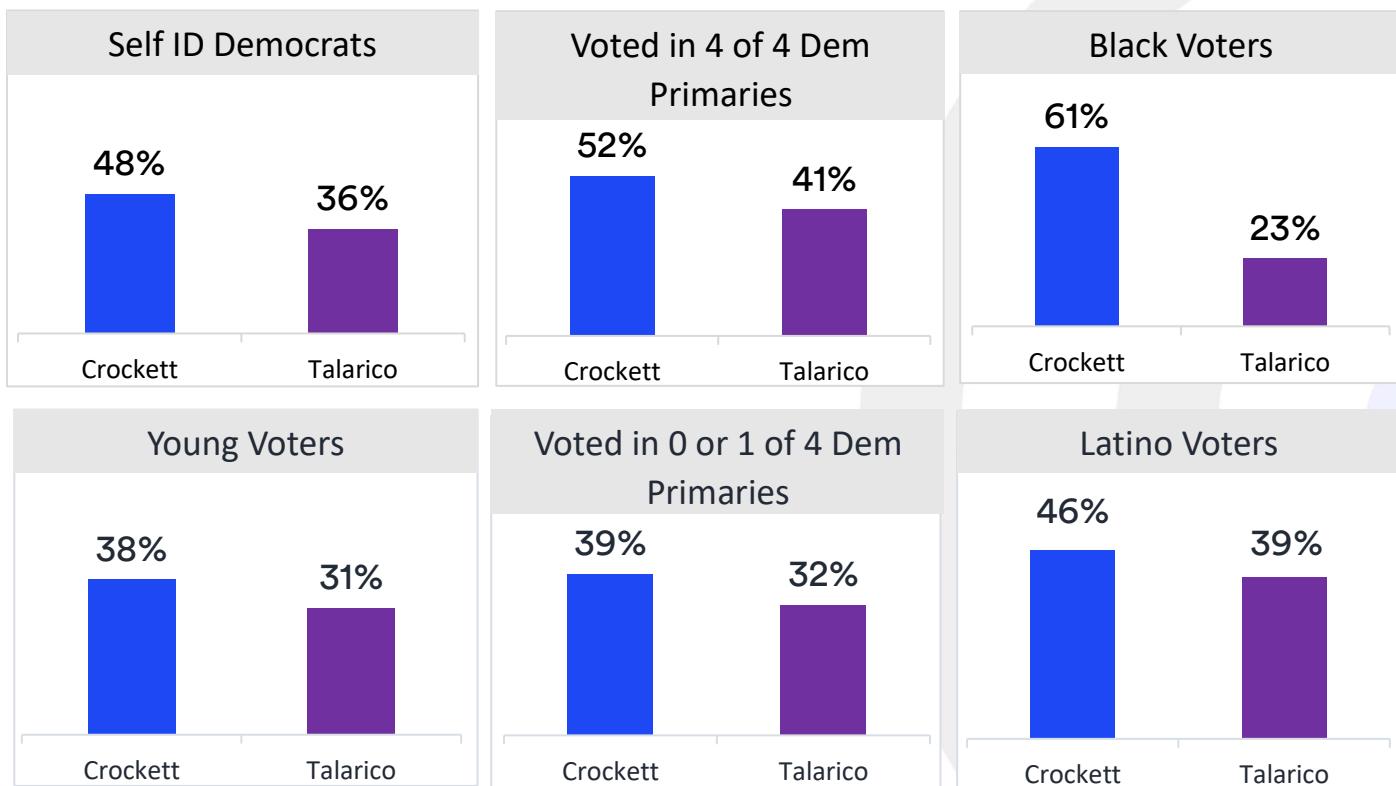
Congresswoman Crockett approaches 50% in the initial horse race, leaving room for her to improve her standing once she engages in paid media and strategic communications with voters. Congresswoman Crockett benefits from very strong name ID (82%) and favorability ratings (65% favorable, 7% unfavorable, +58 favorable) among likely Democratic primary voters.



- **Takeaway #2 – Congresswoman Crockett continues to generate the most voter enthusiasm of Democratic candidates for Senate.** We asked likely Democratic voters whether Crockett and Talarico's candidacies would make voters more likely to vote in the general, less likely to vote, or whether it would make no difference at all. These questions were asked prior to messaging. Among likely Democratic primary voters overall, 43% are more likely to cast a vote if she were the nominee. Among key Democratic constituencies, Congresswoman Crockett generated higher or similar levels of enthusiasm, with strong pluralities or majorities more likely to vote if she were the nominee.

Total More Likely ONLY

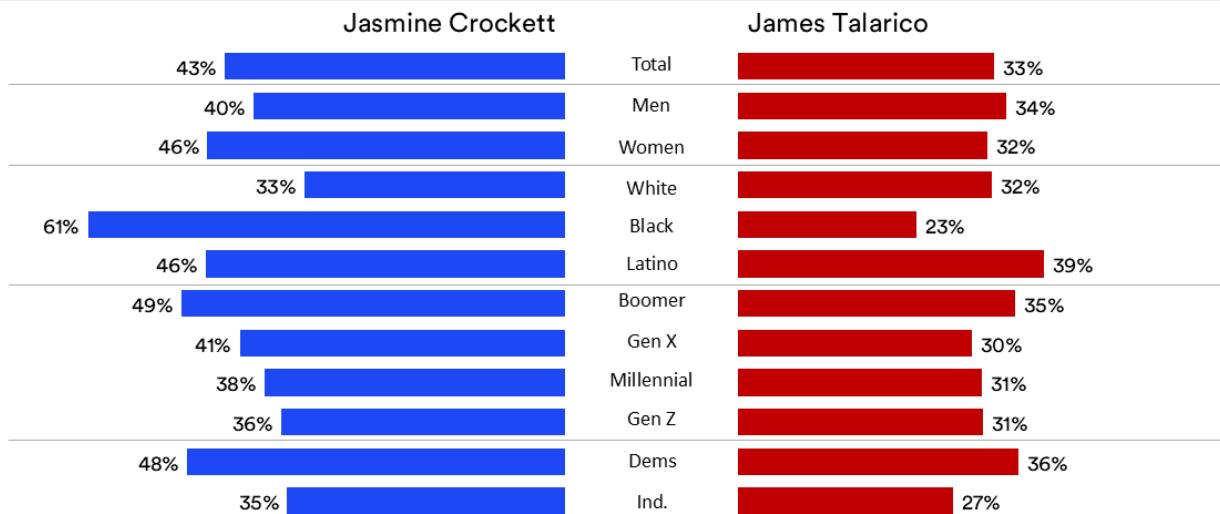


- **Takeaway #3 – Democratic Primary voters believe Congresswoman Crockett is more likely to defeat a Republican than Talarico.** Likely Democratic primary voters believe that Congresswoman Crockett is the Democratic nominee most likely to defeat a Republican candidate in November. Among all Democratic primary voters, 57% of respondents believe she is very/somewhat likely to defeat the Republican nominee in November, compared with 54% who believe the same about Talarico. The gap is even starker among key Democratic constituencies that the Party must turn out in November. Contrary to recent media narratives, Democratic voters themselves believe that the Congresswoman is the most electable Democratic nominee for U.S. Senate. She has the advantage over Talarico in every major Democratic constituency.

This data directly undermines Talarico's electability argument - Democratic voters do not believe that he is more electable.

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- **Takeaway #4 – Democratic coalition continued to erode in 2024 and must be reassembled in 2026.** Consistent with nationwide results, key Democratic constituencies deserted the Texas Democratic Party in 2024. Relative to former Congressman Beto O'Rourke's 2018 performance, former Congressman Colin Allred lost 5 points of support among Black men, 17 points of support among Latinos, and 18 points of support from voters aged 18-29. Key Democratic constituencies either stayed home or voted Republican for the first time in several cycles. The Texas Democratic Party needs a nominee who excites Democratic constituents to reverse this trend.

- ◎ Jasmine Crockett is the best candidate to #1 reassemble the Dem base and #2 expand the general electorate

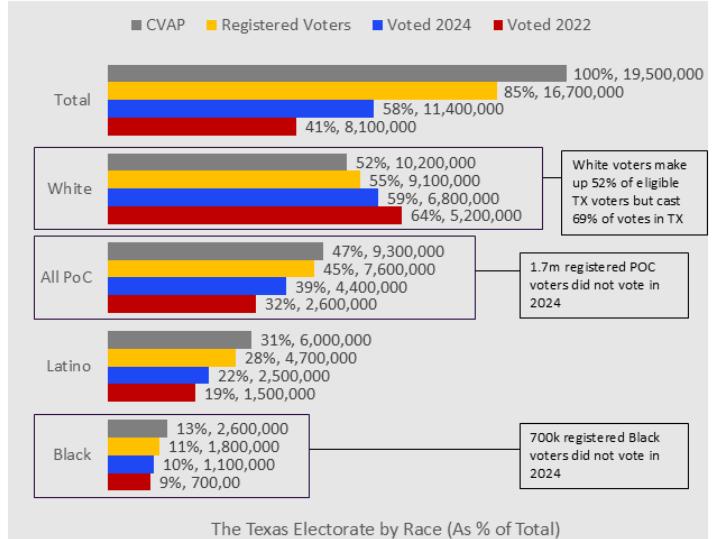
#1 Reassemble the Dem Base

Black voters, Latino voters, and young voters that have eroded from Dems the most are the voters that Jasmine Crockett's candidacy inspires the most.

METHODOLOGY:

HIT Strategies data is from a poll commissioned by Congresswoman Jasmine Crockett to determine her current position among likely Democratic Primary voters. The survey was conducted January 6 – January 15, 2026.

The sample was drawn from the voter file with Primary and General vote history appended. Interviews were conducted by live callers to landlines and cellphones, as well as text-to-web, for a total of 1,005 interviews.

The sample was weighed according to parameters derived from the voter file and ACS data, including age, gender, race/ethnicity, education, vote history, modeled partisanship, and geography.

The overall margin of error for the full sample is +/- 3.21%.
